Senator Tom Butler – Facts

- Served as state senator since 1994 and works as a registered pharmacist.
- Christian Coalition of Alabama approval rating of 56% in 1999-2000 and 65% 2003-2006.
- Voted conservative only 41% of the time in 2004 on 30 key votes as rated by Conservative Christians of Alabama.
- Supported the interests of the Alabama National Federation of Independent Business 60% in 2003-2006.
- National Rifle Association rating of A+ in 2006
- Alabama Taxpayers Defense Fund rated him as voting for tax increases 71% of the time in a 3 year period.
- Received \$24,500 in donations from several PACs, including the Robert Gettie PACs, mostly funded from gambling sources.
- Endorsement of the Alabama AFL-CIO Union.

Bill Holtzclaw – Facts

- President of the Madison City Council.
- Served 20 years in the Marine Corps and retired as a Chief Warrant Officer.
- Worked in several positions in the defense industry in the Huntsville area.
- Independent consultant for the Marine Corps Program Manager for Ammunition to assist in fielding a software accounting platform world-wide.
- Contracts Specialist at Madison Research Corporation and as a Contracts Specialist at NASA's Marshall Space Flight Center in the Office of Procurement.

Representative Henry White – Facts

- Served in the Alabama House since 2006, and previously served on the Athens City Council.
- Union endorsement: Henry White has received the union endorsement of the Alabama AFL-CIO.

Dan Williams - Facts

- Mayor of Athens for 18 years.
- Served 26 years in the Alabama National Guard and retired from the Alabama Department of Human Resources.
